



GOOD NEWS TV TRANSITION – FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS



The Arizona Conference Corporation (AZ Conference) and Good News TV (GNTV) continue to share very close relations, and soul-winning partnership. However, the GC Counsel and Audit Committee have required that GNTV become a separate organization. The following page answers some frequently asked questions.

Does the AZ Conference support this transition for GNTV? Yes, the AZ Conference and GNTV made this decision together. The AZ Conference encourages ongoing and growing support of GNTV.

When is this transition complete? January 1, 2025

Will Arizona church members be able to continue donating to GNTV through their tithe/offering envelope or Adventist Giving website after December 31, 2024? No. These options will be discontinued on January 1, 2025. To continue supporting GNTV, you must start giving directly to the ministry through the methods shared below.

Can I start donating directly to GNTV now instead of waiting? Yes. We encourage you to start donating directly to GNTV right away. Please do not delay. If interested, please use the enclosed GNTV envelope to send your first gift.

How can I donate? Donate on the GNTV website, mail your gift, or call directly. (See GNTV contact info at the bottom.)

Will my donations to GNTV continue to be tax-deductible? Yes. GNTV is a registered 501c3 charitable organization. All gifts are tax-deductible, and you will receive a donation receipt.

Can I set up an automatic monthly gift? Yes. Simply specify your gift frequency when you call or donate online.

How will this transition affect the income for GNTV? Most support for GNTV has come through the tithe/offering envelope and the Adventist Giving website up to this point. Since GNTV will no longer be listed as options through these methods, they will depend on donors to start giving directly to the ministry instead.

How will this transition affect the expenses for GNTV? Expenses will grow considerably as a result of this transition. This is due to additional responsibilities the ministry will be taking on, including staffing; benefits; accounting; insurance; property rental; and more. Therefore, your support today is more important than ever.

Where will GNTV be located after 2024? GNTV will be renting the studio building where they have been operating from on the campus of Thunderbird Adventist Academy in Scottsdale, Arizona.

Will I be contacted directly by GNTV to remind me about this change? No. If you have donated through the tithe/offering envelope or Adventist Giving website, GNTV does not know this. Your information has been kept strictly confidential by the church. Therefore, it will be up to you to make the first contact to GNTV or donate to them.

Will GNTV continue promoting outreach events and worship service invitations for my church? Yes. One of the primary objectives of GNTV is to encourage viewers to find an Adventist church family near them, resulting in considerable church growth through baptisms and professions of faith.

Will GNTV continue to be involved at Arizona Camp Meeting? Yes. GNTV will continue promoting, live streaming, and broadcasting Arizona Camp Meeting, just as it has for many years.

Can we invite GNTV to visit my church? Yes. GNTV is becoming a Supporting Ministry of the Arizona Conference. They are welcome to visit, to share updates and viewer testimonies, and to encourage support.
